

Abstrak

Maraknya siswa yang kebingungan dengan karier di masa depan menandakan bahwa kesiapan karier perlu dipupuk sejak dini. Kesiapan karier menjadi aspek krusial yang dapat membantu individu agar dapat menyesuaikan dan menunjang kapasitas diri dengan kebutuhan di ranah karier, baik dalam hal pekerjaan ataupun perkuliahan. Penelitian ini dilakukan untuk mengetahui pengaruh efikasi diri pengambilan keputusan karier dan dukungan orang tua terhadap kesiapan karier siswa. Pendekatan kuantitatif dengan jenis penelitian kausalitas digunakan sebagai metode dalam penelitian ini. Pengumpulan data dilakukan dengan 3 skala, yaitu *Career Decision-Making Self-Efficacy – Short Form*, *Career-Related Parent Support Scale*, dan *Career Readiness Instruments for Vocational Highschool Students*, yang dibagikan kepada 335 siswa di SMK “X”. Penelitian ini mendapatkan kesimpulan bahwa efikasi diri pengambilan keputusan karier dan dukungan orang tua memberikan pengaruh positif secara parsial dan simultan terhadap kesiapan karier siswa.

Abstract

The rise of students who are confused about their future careers indicates that career readiness needs to be nurtured early on. Career readiness is a crucial aspect that can help individuals to be able to adjust and support their capacity with the needs in the career field, both in terms of work or lectures. This study was conducted to determine the effect of career decision-making self-efficacy and parental support on students' career readiness. A quantitative approach with the type of causal research was used as a method in this study. Data collection was conducted with 3 scales, namely Career Decision-Making Self-Efficacy - Short Form, Career-Related Parent Support Scale, and Career Readiness Instruments for Vocational Highschool Students, which were distributed to 335 students at SMK "X". The study concluded that career decision-making self-efficacy and parental support have partial and simultaneous positive effects on students' career readiness.
