

Abstrak

Hubungan *friend with affection* pada komunitas *roleplayer* menjadi salah satu bentuk hubungan yang berkembang di media sosial dan berpotensi memunculkan *relational uncertainty*. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui pengaruh *self-determination* terhadap *relational uncertainty* pada *roleplayer* yang memilih hubungan *friend with affection* di base SKZFess. Penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan kuantitatif dengan rancangan kausal asosiatif. Subjek penelitian berjumlah 337 *roleplayer* yang dipilih menggunakan teknik *purposive sampling*. Pengumpulan data dilakukan menggunakan *Basic Psychological Need Scale* (BPNS) dan *Relational Uncertainty Measure* (RUM). Analisis data menggunakan regresi linear sederhana. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa *self-determination* tidak berpengaruh secara signifikan terhadap *relational uncertainty*. Mayoritas responden memiliki tingkat *self-determination* yang tinggi dan *relational uncertainty* yang rendah. Temuan ini menunjukkan bahwa *relational uncertainty* pada hubungan *friend with affection* lebih mungkin dipengaruhi oleh faktor lain di luar *self-determination*, seperti dinamika komunikasi, kejelasan ekspektasi, dan interaksi antarindividu.

Abstract

Friend with affection relationships have become increasingly common within roleplayer communities on social media and may contribute to relational uncertainty. This study aimed to examine the effect of self-determination on relational uncertainty among roleplayers who engage in friend with affection relationships in the SKZFess base. This study employed a quantitative approach with an associative causal design. A total of 337 roleplayers were selected using accidental sampling. Data were collected using the Basic Psychological Need Scale (BPNS) and the Relational Uncertainty Measure (RUM). Data were analyzed using simple linear regression. The findings indicated that self-determination did not have a significant effect on relational uncertainty. Most participants demonstrated high levels of self-determination and low levels of relational uncertainty. These findings suggest that relational uncertainty in friend with affection relationships is more likely influenced by other factors, such as communication dynamics, clarity of relationship expectations, and interpersonal interactions.
