Selain itu juga, kedua novel ini terdapat perbedaan dan persamaan dan menjadi novel yang bersambungan satu sama lainnya dan mengarah pada adanya narasi realism karena adanya sejumlah pernyataan yang mengandung kebenaran. Then, both of novels have similarities and differences which those are sequel novel each other and lead to the existence of narrative realism because there is some statements that contained the truth. The similarities is started from some characters. Then, both novels have analepsis and prolepsis. The differences found in point of view, Focalization, and such narrative time.
