

Abstrak

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan seksisme ambivalen dan religiusitas dengan *rape myth acceptance* (RMA) pada mahasiswa yang berkuliah di bandung. Rancangan kuantitatif korelasional digunakan terhadap 129 mahasiswa yang berkuliah di Bandung yang diambil berdasarkan *accidental sampling*. Pengumpulan data dilakukan peneliti menggunakan kuesioner untuk megukur seksisme ambivalen, religiusitas dan RMA.

Penelitian ini mengkonfirmasi hipotesis bahwa terdapat hubungan positif yang signifikan antara seksisme ambivalen, religiusitas, dengan penerimaan mitos pemerkosaan (RMA). Korelasi positif disini dapat diartikan bahwa semakin tinggi tingkat seksisme maka akan semakin tinggi pula tingkat penerimaan mitos pemerkosaan (RMA) (kategori korelasi sedang/ cukup), begitu juga dengan religiusitas, semakin tinggi tingkat religiusitas maka semakin tinggi pula tingkat penerimaan mitos pemerkosaan (RMA) (kategori korelasi lemah).

Abstract

This study aims to determine the relationship between ambivalent sexism and religiosity with rape myth acceptance (RMA) in college students studying in Bandung. A quantitative correlational design was used on 129 students studying in Bandung who were taken based on accidental sampling. Researchers collected data using questionnaires to measure ambivalent sexism, religiosity and RMA. This study confirms the hypothesis that there is a significant positive relationship between ambivalent sexism, religiosity, and acceptance of rape myths (RMA).

This study confirmed the hypothesis that there is a significant positive relationship between ambivalent sexism, religiosity, and rape myth acceptance (RMA). The positive correlation here can be interpreted that the higher the level of sexism, the higher the level of acceptance of rape myths (RMA) (moderate correlation category), as well as religiosity, the higher the level of religiosity, the higher the level of acceptance of rape myths (RMA) (weak correlation category).
