

- 5. In keywords, adding some more specific keywords is suggested to help clarify the research topic. For example, "Digital Divide" or "E-Government" could be relevant keywords for this article.

What are the practical benefits of increasing citizen participation in local democracy using ICT? How can this impact more inclusive decision-making and more sustainable societal development?
- 5. In conclusion, it is advisable to suggest future research directions that could further develop this topic. For example, are certain aspects of ICT that need to be studied more closely, or is there a better understanding of engaging less participating groups in society? Providing recommendations for future research will positively contribute to developing knowledge in this field.
