CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the research

He has own character, experience, views and feelings that are different from others, humans also often experience conflicts within themselves or inner conflicts as a reaction to social situations in their environment.

Knowing how they learn and interact in normal life we are also often faced by humans who have multiple personalities. Seen from mood changes and changes in voice intonation towards different people. From the explanation of this attitude it is not impossible these people were identified as having multiple personality disorders. The development of literary works has produced several new products, one of which is the existence of the film industry. The film itself is a product of literary works, because one of the things that supports film making is through scripts. A script in a film can be likened to a script in a drama, this is as expressed by Tomaric (2011), that the script is a blueprint for the story and contains dialogue, character movements, and scene descriptions. There's an old saying if I'm not on the page, it's me not on stage. Based on what the theory says, the script in a drama is the same as the script in a film. This is determined by the similarity of the drama and film scripts which have several elements. In drama making, the writer uses creative elements so that the drama develops. The

development of literary works that have similarities with scripts is film scripts. A film script is one of the most important elements before it becomes a film. The development of literature also develops from textual to visual due to advances in science and technology.

In understanding a literary work another understanding is needed. A story in a literary work is a world created by an author supported by several constructing elements. Building elements are divided into intrinsic and extrinsic parts. As Nurgiyantoro (2013) argues that the various elements of story building are generally divided into two groups. These groups are extrinsic and intrinsic elements. These groups are often used by the community to study literature in general. He found out firsthand. The parts that are included in the group are themes, element arrangements, plot. characters. characterizations, and points of view.

After understanding some of the elements that make up a literary work, the researcher understands that the role of characters in a story is very important to be able to convey the writer. The characters in a story have different characterizations. In a variety of stories the characters are made in such a way as to resemble behavior in everyday life, so it is not surprising that the shape of the characters in a story is similar to everyday life. Especially Adi (2011: 47) who states that "characterization is one of the most important elements in a novel, because without a character that must be played or done in a novel, there is no story." In every character there must be an action to make the conflict exist. In detective, conflict fiction is more valuable to make a story have tension in each story. Moreover, conflict is one of the important elements of the story. The conflict in this film is a mental illness experienced by Kevin's character.
