Abstract

The phenomenon of marriage in Indonesia is increasingly being carried out by couples of various ages, even students who are pursuing higher education. Therefore, this research aims to examine the decision making of young marriage among UIN Sunan Gunung Djati students. This research uses quantitative methodology, with a sample of 93 married students. Data was then collected using decision-making, motivation and social support scales, which were then analyzed using multiple regression analysis techniques. The research results show that motivation and social support have a simultaneous relationship with the decision to marry young among UIN Sunan Gunung Djati students. This indicates that it is important to increase motivation and support to be able to make the right decisions.
